C I R C U L A R

In continuation of the earlier Circular/Notice and as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in the recent Circular dated 20.03.2020, the following arrangement is made for the week commencing from 23rd March, 2020:

1. At the District Court, Panaji, the Registry shall work for accepting only urgent filing between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on 23rd, 24th, 26th and 27th March 2020, respectively.
2. At the Taluka level, in the Civil Courts at Panaji, Ponda, Mapusa, Bicholim, Pernem and Valpoi, the Registry shall work only with one Clerk, Head Clerk/Superintendent and one Peon for accepting urgent filing between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on 23rd, 24th, 26th and 27th March 2020, respectively.

3. The District Courts at Panaji, Mapusa and Ponda, the following Judicial Officers shall attend remand work at the District level and utmost urgent cases, if any, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on the respective dates:

23rd March 2020 - Ms. Sherin G. Paul
24th March 2020 - Smt. Kshama M. Joshi
26th March 2020 - Smt. Bela N. Naik
27th March 2020 - Smt. Shabnam Shaikh

4. At Civil Court, Panaji, the following Judicial Officers shall attend remand work and utmost urgent cases, if any, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m., on the respective dates:

On 23rd March 2020 - Ms. ArtiKumari Naik
On 22nd and 24th March 2020 - Smt. Ashwini Khandolkar
On 26th March 2020 - Shri Jude Torex Sequeira
On 27th March 2020 - Ms. Pooja Dessai.

However, regular remand work should be attended on 25th, 28th and 29th March 2020 by the regular Remand Judge.

5. At Civil Court, Mapusa, the following Judicial Officers shall attend remand work and utmost urgent cases, if any, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on the respective dates:

On 23rd March 2020 – Shri Carlo Santana Da Silva

On 24th March 2020 - Ms. Shantashri Kudchadkar

On 22nd & 26th March 2020 - Ms. Anuradha Andrade

On 27th March 2020 - Ms. Teisy Mascarenhas.

However, regular remand work should be attended on 25th, 28th and 29th March 2020 by the regular Remand Judge.

6. At Civil Court, Ponda, the following Judicial Officers shall attend remand work and utmost urgent cases, if any, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on the respective dates:

On 22rd, 24th, 26th and 27th - Shri Anil Scaria.

Ms. Pooja Sardessai, the regular Remand Judge shall attend the remand work on 23rd, 25th, 28th and 29th March 2020, respectively.

7. At Civil Court, Bicholim, the following Judicial Officers shall attend remand work and utmost urgent cases, if any, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on the respective dates:

On 23rd, 24th, 26th and 27th - Ms. Kalpana Gavas.

Ms. Suman Gad, the regular Remand Judge shall attend the remand work on 22nd, 25th, 28th and 29th March 2020, respectively.

8. At Civil Courts in Pernem and Valpoi, Judicial Officers shall attend remand work on all working days, holidays and Sundays.

9. The Judicial Officers nominated on respective dates for remand and urgent work shall be considered as remand Judges for the whole day allotted to them.

10. The dates for the matters fixed on 23rd, 24th, 26th and 27th March 2020 shall be uploaded today on the website before 4.00 p.m. by posting all those matters on 27th, 28th, 29th and 30th April, 2020, respectively and such notice should be placed outside each Court.

11. Advocates Associations to be intimated in advance at each Taluka places.

12. The pre-litigation matters, mediation matters in DLSA shall be adjourned and fixed directly in second week of April, 2020 by giving the dates and if possible by intimating the Advocates and Mediators accordingly.
13. In the Office of DLSA, only one staff member should attend the Office on rotation basis on 23rd, 24th, 26th and 27th March 2020, respectively from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
14. All other Judicial Officers and staff will not be required to attend Courts from 23rd March 2020 till 29th March 2020. In case of urgency and on the instructions of Principal District Judge, the Judicial Officers and concerned staff shall attend the office as and when directed.
15. Only one staff and peon of all the above Judicial Officers shall attend the Court proceedings for the above period.
